Salt Lake City International is One of the Best Airports for Tech Travelers
PC World Magazine Survey Results

PC World Magazine recently visited the nation's 40 largest airports to test Wi-Fi quality, cell phone reception and even counted available electrical outlets to determine which airports make the best hosts for today's technology oriented travelers. The magazine's airport auditors visited 3,300 airline gates from coast to coast, counted more than 17,000 electrical outlets, 5,000 USB ports and 1,350 charging stations. They also conducted hundreds of Wi-Fi and cellular service tests.

Salt Lake City International Airport ranked 27th out of the 40 airports tested. It is one of the few airports in the country offering free Wi-Fi. In addition, the Airport has made electrical outlets available throughout the facility and has worked with its airline partners to provide them at the gates for passengers to use to charge electronic devices. The Airport also features fast, reliable cell phone service.
