Passengers Increase at Salt Lake City International Airport

The Salt Lake City International Airport served 21,016,686 passengers in 2010. This is a 2.86% increase in passenger numbers with 584,468 additional passengers compared to calendar year 2009.

The Airport served 523,106 international passengers which is a 21.28% increase compared to 2009 with 91,802 additional international passengers.

Eight airlines serve the Airport which is the 25th busiest in the nation. It is a major hub for Delta Air Lines.

Cargo traffic has also seen an increase. It was up 7.14% in 2010 compared to calendar year 2009 with a total of 310,059,497 pounds. That is 20,660,644 pounds more than the previous calendar year.

Overall, there were 362,654 take-offs and landings at Salt Lake City International Airport in 2010 including commercial air traffic, general aviation and military activity.

"This is an encouraging trend," comments Maureen Riley, Airport Executive Director, "It indicates a more healthy economic environment than we have experienced the past few years and we are very pleased to see traffic returning."
