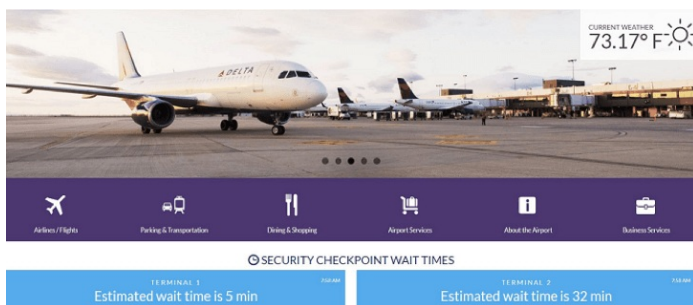

Wait Times for Security Screening at SLC Now on Airport Monitors and Website



A new queue management system installed at the Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) takes the guess work out of how long it will take to go through the security screening lines. The new system uses cameras and Bluetooth technology to track wait times—real time—in security screening lines, which are then posted to the SLC Airport monitors and well as on slcairport.com

Five, 49 inch monitors are located at the entrance to the checkpoints in both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. The technology detects and tracks passengers anonymously as they enter the security screening line and continue through the line to the screening exit.

The new technology not only assists passengers, but also increases the accuracy of passenger flow and wait-time data for the SLC Airport and Transportation Security Administration (TSA) when managing busy screening times. SLC has been experiencing record passenger numbers and has experienced 64 months of continual passenger growth.

Delta's New A220 Takes Off from SLC

On April 16, Delta's new Airbus A220-100 aircraft began flying nonstop between SLC and DFW. The A220 is a more efficient aircraft with amenities such as extra-large windows, high-capacity overhead bins and seat-back screens. The aircraft also has a restroom window.

New Air Service to SLC

✈ Delta started nonstop service between Columbus, Ohio (CMH) and SLC on June 24. On August 12, nonstop service between SLC and Santa Barbara (SBA) begins.

✈ Delta's nonstop service to London will begin mid-December 2019 rather than in April 2020 on an Airbus 330. The airline will operate the service five times weekly from December through February before going weekly from March through mid-October.

✈ Frontier has announced nonstop service from SLC to Phoenix will begin in November 2019.
