A GLOBAL CONNECTION

As the first new U.S. hub airport built in the 21st Century, Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) is the global gateway to the Western U.S. and some of the nation's most iconic national parks and ski resorts.

AN ECONOMIC FORCE

SLC is a major economic engine for the region and a critical component of the national air transportation network. Pre-pandemic, SLC supported an estimated 124,407 total jobs, an annual spending of \$7.2 billion and total annual economic activity estimated at about \$11.5 billion.

A SELF-SUSTAINING ENTITY

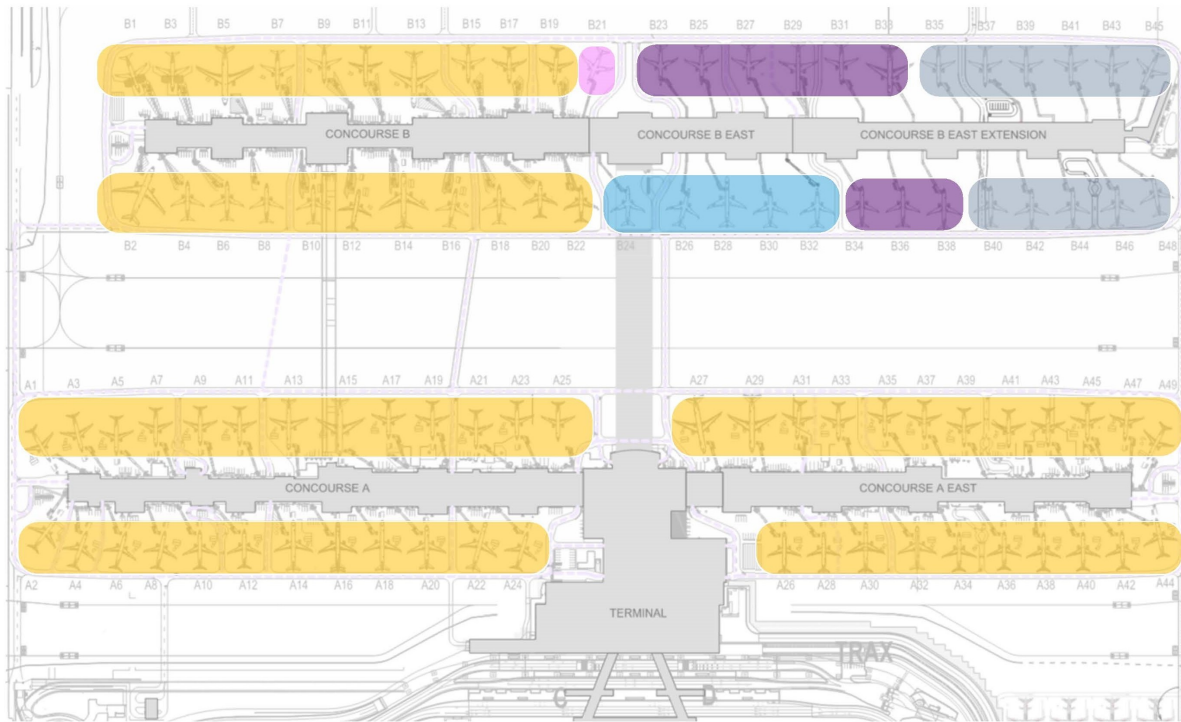
SLC is managed by a department of Salt Lake City Corporation, but it is operated through a separate enterprise fund generated from user fees. No local taxpayer dollars contribute to the airport's operation.

THE NEW SLC: FUTURE PHASES

- 68 CURRENT GATES OPEN
- 05 GATES OPEN OCT OF 2024
- 09 GATES OPEN OCT OF 2025
- 01 GATES OPEN OCT OF 2025
- 11 GATES OPEN OCT OF 2026



The map above shows the phased opening of gates on the east sides of both concourses.

PHASES 3 & 4

Phases 3 & 4 of the Airport Redevelopment Program includes the build out of 26 gates on Concourse B to the east and the Central Tunnel.

Phase 3 will also 19,260 sq. ft. of food, beverage and retail space to the airport. A mix of local and national brands were selected for the new space, including Cotopaxi, Freddy's Frozen Custard and Steakburgers, Maggiano's Little Italy, Sunday's Best, and Thirst.

PHASING TIMELINE

Phase 1: Opened September 2020

Central terminal, parking garage, elevated roadway; west portions of Concourses A and B

Phase 2: 2023

22-gate build out of Concourse A to the east

Phase 3: 2024/25

Central Tunnel; addition of 10 gates to Concourse B

Phase 4: 2027

Addition of 16 gates to Concourse B
