FASTEST HOUSING UNIT GROWTH

In May, the U.S. Census released updated population and housing estimates for July 1, 2022. For the second year in a row, Utah ranked #1 for fastest housing unit growth, with an increase of nearly 39,000 units. Wasatch County (near SLC metro) also ranked #1 for housing on a county level.

RECENT POPULATION GROWTH

Utah cities continue to rank high for growth, with Eagle Mountain (Salt Lake suburb), now officially recognized as a large city by the U.S. Census, with over 50,000 residents. Also, Lehi (Salt Lake suburb) recently ranked among the top 15 fastest growing large U.S. cities.
