



GENERAL AVIATION BADGING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

BADGING OFFICE LOCATION AND HOURS

The badging office is located at 220 North 3700 West at Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC). The office is open weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., excluding holidays, and 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Thursdays.

WHEN CAN I RENEW MY BADGE?

Tenants may renew badges up to six weeks prior to the expiration date printed on the front of the badge. It's best to plan ahead and not wait until a badge is about to expire.

AM I REQUIRED TO TAKE A TRAINING CLASS FOR A GENERAL AVIATION BADGE?

Security training is mandatory for all general aviation hangar tenants. Training takes approximately 90 minutes. SLC hangar tenants must also complete a TSA Security Threat Assessment that typically takes between two to 14 days to clear.

ARE APPOINTMENTS NECESSARY AND HOW DO I SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT?

Appointments are strongly recommended since there is no guaranteed openings for walk-in customers. Schedule an appointment by calling 801-575-2423.

WHO CAN SIGN MY BADGE APPLICATION?

Airport Properties must sign applications for lease holders. Tenants may sign for individuals they authorize to use their hangar. Contact Phil Bevan at 801-575-2957 or phil.bevan@slcgov.com to get an application signed.

AMERICAN BONANZA SOCIETY PLANNING EVENTS THIS SUMMER AT SOUTH VALLEY REGIONAL AIRPORT

The American Bonanza Society (ABS) is holding two events at South Valley Regional this summer.

From May 4 through 5, a mechanic's service clinic will be held to teach participants how to perform proper inspections on Beech Bonanzas, including fixing common squawks and proper landing gear inspections.

Then from August 15 through 18, the ABS Air Safety Foundation will conduct a service clinic for Bonanza owners. The clinic brings in recognized Beech service experts to perform highly structured and comprehensive visual inspections of Beech Bonanzas.

These events are expected to bring up to 20 aircraft to the South Valley Regional Airport.
