



U42 Runway Scheduled to Open on June 6 at 23:00L

Construction crews are working diligently to make the targeted opening date of June 6 at 23:00 L for runway 16/34 at South Valley Regional. However, taxiways at the north and south thresholds of the runway will not be ready for the June 6 opening. Aircraft will need to taxi back from taxiways A2 and A3 for full length takeoff. The runway will be limited to King Air size aircraft or smaller until June 10.

Users are reminded that there are never any certainties when it comes to construction and Utah weather, so dates are subject to change.

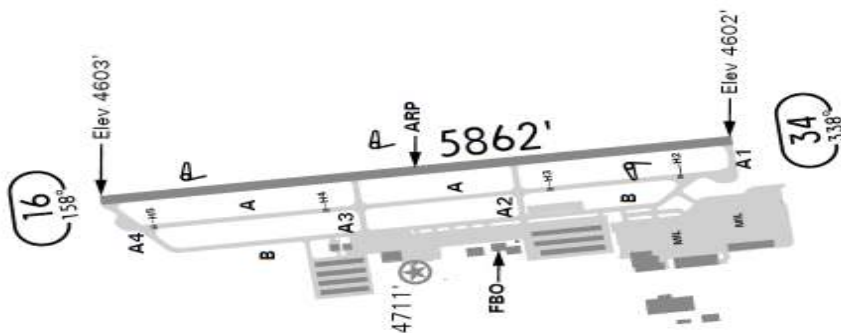
Tenants are encouraged to monitor NOTAMs for the most current and up to date information concerning construction impacts.
