

U42 Runway Closure Requires Additional Closure Days ... Closure Now May 20-June 6

Adverse weather has caused construction delays with the South Valley Regional Airport taxiway construction and runway overlay project. The runway will need to be closed for three additional days in June to allow for the tie-in of taxiway A-1 with the runway. The closure of runway 16/34 at U42 will be from 06:00L on May 20 to 23:00L on June 6.

Users are reminded that there are never any certainties when it comes to construction and Utah weather. Dates are subject to change.

Tenants are encouraged to monitor NOTAMs for the most current and up to date information concerning construction impacts.
